Be a Good Neighbor

3600 Condominium Association provides the benefit of living independently in a communal environment but all residents should remember they have neighbors and should extend the following courtesies to those neighbors.

- Be respectful and considerate of all residents.
- Noise from one unit can often be heard in surrounding units. Residents should follow common sense to reduce noise that can be transmitted from one unit in to other units. Things you can do to help minimize this transfer of noise includes removing shoes, particularly high heels and boots, when walking in your unit; keeping the volume of televisions, stereos, musical instruments and other noiseproducing devices at an acceptable level; restricting any noise-making activities to after 8:00 a.m. and before 9:00 p.m. each day.
- Unit remodeling/construction is only permitted on Mondays through Saturdays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Remodeling/construction is prohibited on Sundays and designated holidays.
- As soon as a machine cycle is complete, laundry room washers and dryers should always be emptied to free up availability to other residents. Laundry should never be left in the laundry room machines after the machine's cycle is complete.
- All garbage, including cat litter, must be placed in a sealed bag before placing in the chute. Failure to do so results in unsanitary conditions for everyone on your floor.
