### **Preparing for Winter**

With winter upon us, keeping the building warm is a top priority. Here are some recommendations for keeping your unit warm during the frigid months ahead:

- Be sure that you have the correct size air conditioning unit for your window.
   Any incorrectly sized unit could cause drafts to seep through into your apartment.
- •Have your air conditioning units winterized by placing a work order. Building staff will ensure that they are properly sealed and don't allow any drafts inside. Important to note is that air conditioning units not properly sealed (i.e., covered with jackets or blankets) could cause frozen pipes in the building.
- •Keep your windows closed. This may seem obvious; however, some residents may not realize that windows are open slightly. Be sure to check that they are completely closed.
- •If you happen to notice air infiltration from the windows in your unit, please report it to Management. Building staff can look into the issue and try to find a resolution.
- •Place a work order to have staff clean the coils in your unit's radiator.
- •Keep vents and areas around vents clear from objects to ensure that heat is reaching all areas of the unit.
